In fact, a month ago we were out and removed all of the covers and straw from our putting surfaces. This was a huge undertaking and necessary given the fact that there were such mild temperatures and hot sun shining down on the exposed winter covers. This was great to get these covers off and it puts us ahead of the game when we can finally get out there on a regular basis. Course access across the field road is an issue along with the wet, cold conditions and potentially more snow over the next few days makes planning and early work very difficult. Please do not attempt to drive to the course for any reason until an announcement is posted on our site that it is ok to do so. You will get stuck trying to cross that road. Our intent is to get out there as a grounds crew and begin course preparation and further maintenance beginning Monday April 15. There is much to do, straw needs to be picked up and hauled away, and there are many trees down that need to be removed from fairways and green complexes before play can begin. We will plan a couple of clean up days once we can safely get to the course and volunteers will be needed. We will open the course when it is fit for play and access can be made safely to the course. Undoubtedly some courses will open before Aroostook Valley Country Club this Spring, but I am hoping none will open in any better condition! Early indications are that the greens look good. I expect this to be the case at all the courses this year given the mild winter. I am hoping that the fact that we have still have our germination tarps on the greens will safe guard us against all of this freezing and thawing at this late stage. I am optimistic!
